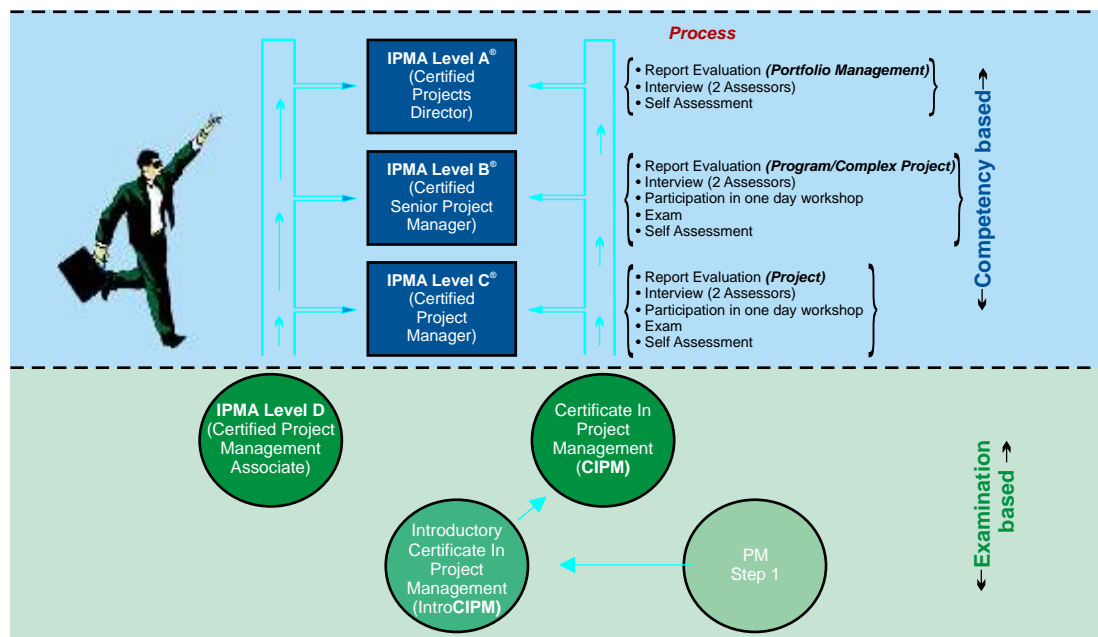

Institute of Project Management Certification (IPMC), a non profit company incorporated under Section 25 of the Companies Act 1956, is the National Certification Body of PMA India. IPMC is a nodal agency for awarding various PM Certifications in India.

IPMC has signed an agreement with IPMA to administer and award their prestigious 4 Level Certification in India. IPMC is also responsible for the award of "Certificate In Project Management (CIPM)". The activities of IPMC are coordinated by IPMA through the Certification Validation Management Board (CVMB), Validators and the Certification System Panel (CSP). IPMC has been duly accredited and validated by IPMA in accordance with the principals of ISO 17024:2003.

IPMC plans to promote new certifications in the IT & Infrastructure disciplines. IPMC has created a benchmark in the area of Project Management Certification. IPMC fulfills the aspirations of Indian professional community to get certified in Project Management from their National Body.

Project Management Knowledge Quotient (PMKQ™) from PMA, India



PMA, India has introduced a unique product in self assessment of individuals' knowledge of the contemporary concepts of Project Management. The assessment is done across 8 Project Life Cycle phases covering 21 Knowledge Areas and 30 PM Concepts. The ranking is done on a scale of 0-10 with negative marking to discourage people to 'guess'. The assessment is very versatile and can be carried out at various levels across the organization - Company wise, Department wise, Functional areas, Designation wise, Project wise and at Individual level.
